

**RESOLUTION NO. 2012-01**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE HARBOUR WATERWAY SPECIAL DISTRICT, DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA, STATING ITS INTENTION TO UTILIZE THE UNIFORM METHOD FOR COLLECTING NON-AD VALOREM ASSESSMENTS, AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 197.3632, FLORIDA STATUTES, WITHIN THE DISTRICT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Harbor Waterway Special District (“District”) was duly created and empowered by the City of Jacksonville, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2010-725-E (“Ordinance”), and therein given the authority, among other things, to levy non-ad valorem assessments on the lots and parcels within its geographic boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance authorizes levy and collection of non-ad valorem assessments for the purpose of the continuing maintenance of the system of canals located in the areas within its geographic boundaries; and

WHEREAS, it is the District’s intention to utilize the Uniform Method for Collecting Non-Ad Valorem Assessments, as authorized and set forth in Section 167.3632, Florida Statutes, for purposes of levying and collecting non-ad valorem assessments on lots and parcels within the District, as more fully described below; and

WHEREAS, prior to the adoption of this Resolution, notice of a public hearing to consider adoption of this Resolution was duly published for 4 consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in Duval County, Florida, giving notice of the District’s intention to utilize the Uniform Method for Collection of Non-Ad Valorem Assessment and the date of the public hearing at which this Resolution would be considered for adoption; and

WHEREAS, prior to adoption of this Resolution, a public hearing was conducted thereon.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of the District as follows:

Section 1. Commencing with fiscal year 2012-2013 and continuing annually thereafter, the District will utilize the Uniform Method for Collection of Non-Ad Valorem Assessments for levy and collection of non-ad valorem assessments, as set forth in Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, within the geographic boundaries of the District.




