

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE HARBOUR WATERWAY SPECIAL DISTRICT, DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING EXECUTION OF AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE DUVAL COUNTY TAX COLLECTOR AND PROPERTY APPRIASER FOR COLLECTION OF NON-AD VALOREM ASSESSMENTS WITHIN THE DISTRICT PURSUANT TO SECTION 197.3632, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors of the Harbour Waterway Special District (“District”) has this day adopted a Resolution stating its intention to utilize the Uniform Method for Collecting of Non-Ad Valorem Assessments (“Uniform Method”), as described in Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, on parcels and lots within the District: and


WHEREAS, Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, requires special districts electing to utilize the Uniform Method to enter into an agreement with the Property Appraiser and Tax Collector for the county in which the District is located for reimbursement to those agencies for necessary administrative costs incurred by them to levy, collect and enforce the non-ad valorem assessments adopted by the District.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of the District:

Section 1. The Chairman of the Board or the Secretary/Treasurer is authorized to execute, on behalf of the District the Interlocal Agreement between the District, the Duval County Property Appraiser and the Duval County Tax Collector, attached hereto as Exhibit “A,” addressing reimbursement to these agencies by the District for the necessary administrative costs associated with the levy, collection, and enforcement of the District’s planned non-ad valorem assessments.


Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
