TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 10, 2015 MEETING MINUTES

Introduction

The Harbour Waterway Special District (HWSD) meeting of the Board of Supervisors was held at the Resurrection Episcopal Church on February 10, 2015. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Stanley Pipes. In attendance were Paul Stroup, Robert Schleef and Stanley Pipes. It was noted that there was a quorum present. HWSD Attorney Wayne Flowers was present. Kathryn Boucher was present as recording secretary.

Administrative

Approval of Minutes from January 13, 2014 – Motion made to approve the minutes as written; motion passed.

District Business

Appointment of vacant Board Seat 1 to finish out term for William Hibbard – Lindsey Brock is interested in joining the board and will attend the next meeting. A notice announcing the election of board members needs to be published at least 10 days before the election at the meeting next month.

Election of Officers — Officers are elected for 2 year terms. Motion made to nominate Robert Birtalan as Chairman of the Board of Supervisors; motion passed. Resolution 2015-01 to elect Robert Birtalan as Chairman of the Board of Supervisors passed unanimously. Motion made to nominate Robert Schleef as Vice Chairman of the Board of Supervisors; motion passed. Resolution 2015-02 to elect Robert Schleef as Vice Chairman of the Board of Supervisors passed unanimously. Motion made to nominate Stanley Pipes as Secretary/Treasurer of the Board of Supervisors; motion passed. Resolution 2015-03 to elect Stanley Pipes as Secretary/Treasurer of the Board of Supervisors passed unanimously.

Ordinance 2010-725-E Amendment – The board received the final version from Jodie Brooks. The bill will be introduced to the City Council on February 11th. A vote should come before July. Once passed, the rules and regulations for the waterway will need to be set by the HWSD Board, as the ordinance delegates this responsibility to the district. The HWA responsibilities will also be assigned to the District. Wayne Flowers will stay in touch with Clay Yarborough's office.

Form 1 – Supervisor of Elections – Due July 1st

Spoil Site Procurement – Reed Island – This issue remains on the table.

Financial

2014 Non-Ad Valorem Assessment – 89.8% of the funds due has been collected so far, for a total of \$193,164.08. 11 households have not yet paid. There is one bankruptcy outstanding.

Principal & Interest Due May 1 on 2012 & 2013 Series Bonds

Resolution 2015-04 – Approval of Roy Miller Contract – Motion made to approve the 3 year contract with Roy Miller & Associates to provide auditing services to HWSD; motion passed.

Annual Budget Due to City Council – March 31 – This must be approved in the next meeting.

Approval to disburse funds – Motion made to approve disbursements for legal, administrative and liability insurance for \$4,726.00; motion passed. The projected ending balance after disbursements and debt service is \$55,930.50.

WHEREAS, Section 6 of the Ordinance requires that an audit of the HWSD's finances be conducted annually; and

WHEREAS, Roy Miller & Associates ("Miller") is a Certified Public Accounting firm experienced in conducting audits of local governmental bodies and is familiar with the reporting requirements for such audits as specified by federal and state law; and

WHEREAS, Miller has presented a proposal, attached as Exhibit "A" hereto, to the HWSD to perform the annual audit work required by the HWSD to comply with the Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the HWSD:

Section 1. The Miller proposal attached as Exhibit "A" is accepted by the Board.

Section 2. The Chairman of the Board is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Miller for the services described in Miller's proposal on the terms specified in Miller's proposal.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.

ORDINANCE 2015-

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2010-725-E THAT ESTABLISHED AND EMPOWERED THE HARBOUR WATERWAY SPECIAL DISTRICT (THE "DISTRICT") BY AMENDING THE STATED PURPOSE OF THE DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF DISTRICT RULES PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2010-725-E created and empowered Harbour Waterway Special District in accordance with Section 189.4041, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council would like to continue maintenance of the system of canals located in The Harbour neighborhood, Harbour North neighborhood, Harbour Cay neighborhood and Harbour Island neighborhood; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Ordinance 2010-725-E amended. Ordinance 2010-725-E, Sections 2, 4 and 5, is amended in part, and as amended shall read as follows:

"Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the District shall be continuing maintenance of the system of canals located in The Harbour neighborhood, Harbour North neighborhood, Harbour Cay neighborhood, and Harbour Island neighborhood. District shall fulfill its purpose by dredging the canals, dredging the channel that provides the canals with access to the St. Johns River, maintaining a jetty, and maintaining navigational aids. To facilitate dredging the canals, the District may also enforce standards for docks and other

structures located in the canals, and activities in the canals when dredging is ongoing."

* * *

Section 4. Powers. The District is authorized and empowered:

- (A) To sue and be sued;
- (B) To contract;
- (C) To purchase, hold, lease, sell, or otherwise acquire and convey such real property and personal property and interest therein as may be necessary or proper to carry out the purpose of this Charter;
- (D) To employ engineers, attorneys, accountants, financial or other consultants, and such other agents and employees as the Board of Supervisors may require or deem necessary to accomplish the purpose of this Charter, or to contract for any such services;
- (E) To acquire, construct, maintain, equip, improve, extend and enlarge capital projects for the purposes of enabling the District to perform public functions or services as herein provided;
- (F) To borrow money for the purposes of enabling the District to perform public functions or services as herein provided;
- (G) To assess for each year of its operation against each residential lot and each parcel with a canal access easement in the District a special assessment not to exceed \$2,000, and each parcel used for a marina a special assessment not to exceed \$4,000, to be billed and collected as provided by state and local law, and to be a lien on the assessed property, coequal with the lien of all state, county, district

and municipal taxes, and superior in dignity to all other liens, titles and claims, until paid in full;

- (H) To fix and collect rates, fees, and other charges for the specialized public functions or services authorized by this act;
- (I) To restrain, enjoin, or otherwise prevent the violation of this act or any resolution or rule adopted pursuant to the powers granted by this act;
- (J) To join with any other district, municipality, county or political subdivision, public agency or authority in the exercise of common powers;
- (K) To enter into contracts with government of the United States or any agency or instrumentality thereof, or with any state, county, municipality, district, authority or political subdivision, private corporation, partnership, association, or individual to effect the purpose of this act, and to receive and accept from any federal agency, grants or loans for or in aid of the specialized public functions or services authorized herein.
- (L) To adopt rules, as further described in Section 5 below, regarding control over structures and activities within the canals that affect the ability of the District to dredge and otherwise maintain the canals."

"Section 5. (1) To facilitate and implement the District's authority to dredge and maintain the canals within the District, the District is authorized to adopt rules regulating and controlling structures and activities within and adjacent to the canals including the following:
