TUESDAY, JANUARY 13, 2015 MEETING MINUTES

### Introduction

The Harbour Waterway Special District (HWSD) meeting of the Board of Supervisors was held at the Resurrection Episcopal Church on January 13, 2015. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Robert Birtalan. In attendance were Robert Birtalan, Paul Stroup, Robert Schleef and Stanley Pipes. It was noted that there was a quorum present. Attorney Howard Cohn was present on behalf of HWSD Attorney Wayne Flowers. Kathryn Boucher was present as recording secretary.

### **Administrative**

Approval of Minutes from November 11, 2014 – Motion made to approve the minutes as written; motion passed.

### **District Business**

Appointment of vacant Board Seat 1 to finish out term for William Hibbard – Lindsey Brock and Joe Baglino were discussed as a potential candidates. Robert Schleef will discuss the position with Lindsey.

Ordinance 2010-725-E Amendment – Regulations on Dock & Bulkhead Construction – Jodie Brooks has received the latest draft of the amendment and the board is waiting for a reply. The clause regarding the movement of vessels had been removed from the draft.

Form 1 -Supervisor of Elections – Due July  $1^{st} -$ The board members were reminded to submit their forms. This must be handled every year.

Spoil Site Procurement – Reed Island – This issue remains on the table.

### **Financial**

2014 Non-Ad Valorem Assessment – 80.1% of funds have been collected for a total of \$172,156.05. More households have chosen the installment payment plan than did last year.

Principal & Interest Due May 1 on 2012 & 2013 Series Bonds - \$128,000 for principal and \$9,757.40 for interest.

Roy Miller Audit Agreement – The agreement was presented to the board, which is exactly the same as last year's. The agreement is for three years, at \$3,000 per year. The cost may increase by the CPI each year. Motion made to approve the agreement as presented; motion passed.

Approval to disburse funds for Legal and Administrative services – All payments made over the last 2 months were presented. Motion made to approve January disbursement of \$775.00; motion passed. The projected ending balance after disbursements and debt service is \$44,663.64.

### **District Schedule**

Next Scheduled Board Meeting – The next meeting will be February 10, 2015 at Resurrection Episcopal Church.

### Other Business

Legal and Compliance Issues - Nothing at this time.

### Comments and Questions from the Audience

Former chairman William Hibbard was present. Regarding the proposed ordinance, William reminded the board that the covenants from the neighborhoods were signed over to the HWSD at its inception.

William Hibbard received a certificate from the Florida Dept. of State stating that he was elected to the HWSD, despite the fact that he resigned his position. He presented it to the board so that they could investigate any potential mistakes in the state records.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:12 PM. The next monthly board of supervisors meeting is scheduled for Feb 11, 2015.
