MEETING MINUTES

Introduction

The Harbour Waterway Special District (HWSD) meeting of the Board of Supervisors was held at the Resurrection Episcopal Church on October 14, 2014. The meeting was called to order at 7:29 PM by Robert Birtalan. In attendance were Robert Birtalan, Robert Schleef and Stanley Pipes. It was noted that there was a quorum present. HWSD Attorney Wayne Flowers was present. Kathryn Boucher was present as recording secretary.

Administrative

Approval of Minutes from August 12, 2014 – Motion made to approve the minutes as written; motion passed.

District Business

Appointment of vacant Board Seat 1 to finish out term for William Hibbard – No interested candidates have contacted the board members. There was a discussion of trying to have a representative from each of the neighborhood associations. There is currently no representation from Harbour North Court.

2014 non-Ad Valorem Tax – Due to Property Appraiser July 25th – All required documents have been submitted. Funds have begun to come in from installment payments.

Annual Audit – The audit has been completed.

Election Year for Board of Supervisors Seats 2 and 4 – Robert Schleef has not received any official notification of winning his race. He is unopposed for his seat.

Marine Survey – 1 year after dredge – Channel 1A and 1B have silted in 8,000 cubic yards. The average silting rate for the different channels was calculated and presented to the board. At the current rate, it will be necessary to dredge channel 1A and 1B relatively soon. The cost of using Reed Island for a future dredge is too much to be feasible, without some sort of deal being reached. In the meantime, a way to reduce the influx of silt from the cove needs to be agreed upon.

Ordinance 2010-725-E Amendment – Regulations on Dock & Bulkhead Construction – The most recent edit from Jodie Brooks was presented to the board. The board will be given authority over regulation of the canal, rather than the City Council. There is a disagreement regarding the right of the board to move boats that are in the way of the dredge. Wayne Flowers has been working with Jodie Brooks on the

issue. The biggest concern regarding boats left out during the canal is potential damage to personal property. The option of threatening a lawsuit brought against a boat owner by a homeowner's association or the district was discussed, based on the boat owner impeding the maintenance of the canal, which could decrease home values in the area. Fines could be used, rather than the threat of a tow.

Spoil Site Procurement – Reed Island – This issue remains on the table. William Hibbard and Mike Brandy were interested in working on this cause.

Financial

Interest Due Nov. 1 on 2012 & 2013 Series Bonds - \$9,757.40 is due on November 1.

Approval to disburse funds for Interest, Accounting, and Administrative Services — Disbursements made in August and September were presented to the board. The general liability insurance came due. The Special District Association rates have gone up, since the introductory period is over. Motion made to approve upcoming disbursement of \$13,817.37; motion passed. The projected ending balance after disbursements is \$36,222.32
