MEETING MINUTES

Introduction

The Harbour Waterway Special District (HWSD) meeting of the Board of Supervisors was held at the Resurrection Episcopal Church on May 9, 2017. The meeting was called to order at 7:02 PM by Robert Birtalan. In attendance were Robert Birtalan, Robert Schleef, and Stanley Pipes. It was noted that there was a quorum present. Attorney John Wallace was present on behalf of Wayne Flowers. Kathryn Amason was present as recording secretary.

Administrative

Approval of Minutes from April 11, 2017 – Motion made to approve the minutes as amended to correct the amount to be paid to Amec Foster Wheeler; motion passed.

District Business

Spoil Site Procurement – Reed Island – The final consent to easement was received from the USACE. The TCLP analysis was completed and the report was presented to the board. The arsenic levels from 7 of the 8 samples are high for residential property but within an acceptable range for commercial property. The condition of the berms was discussed. Robert Birtalan indicated that there has been no update yet regarding the planning commission issue. The plan is to have the City handle the rezoning of Reed Island either by allowing an exception or rezoning, so that the HWSD will not have to pay the cost of rezoning. Closing is anticipated within the next 60-90 days.

Amec Foster Wheeler Environment – Joe Wagner – The report has been written and is under review. This week it should be released to the board and the FDEP.

LLW – Title Commitment – This is under review.

BB&T Funding Proposal – The proposal from BB&T was presented to the board. The financing is for \$300,000 at a rate of 4.19% for 10 years.

Navigational Aids – Marker 17 - One side of marker 17 is missing. A replacement has been ordered.

Waterway Rules & Dock Approvals:

No Trespassing Signage - The signs should be put in place this week. There was a discussion of new Neighborhood Watch signs that are available to waterways.

Financial

HWSD non-Ad Valorem Assessment:

2016 non-Ad Valorem Assessment - Status - 98.6% of the total amount billed has been collected to date, for a total distribution of \$197,701.35. 2 properties remain outstanding. One property is being sold and its assessment should be paid soon.

2017 non-Ad Valorem Assessment:

Property Appraiser Sends Tax Roll – June 1, 2017

HWSD Public Hearing – July 11, 2017

Fiscal Year Budget – Status:

2017-18 FY Budget – The budget was submitted and is waiting on Finance Committee review.

Approval to disburse funds – Motion made to approve disbursements for the spoil site engineering report, web hosting, office supplies, signage, administrative and legal services totaling \$3,737.38; motion passed. After all projected debt service and projected assessment collection, the total of the disposable funds remaining in the BB&T checking account is \$150,793.19.

District Schedule

Adopt 2017-18 Meeting Schedule – The proposed meeting schedule was presented to the board. Motion made to approve the schedule as written; motion passed.

Next Scheduled Board Meeting – The next meeting will be June 13, 2017 at Resurrection Episcopal Church.

Other Business

Legal and Compliance Issues – Form 1 for board members is due to the Supervisor of Elections on July 1st.

Paul Stroup has informed the board that he will be resigning his board seat because he is moving out of the district. His formal resignation letter has not yet been received. A replacement must be appointed to fill out Paul's term which extends through 2018. Board Seat 1 remains vacant as well.



Branch Banking and Trust Company (“BB&T”) is pleased to offer this proposal for the financing requested by Harbour Waterway Special District (“District”).

- (1) **Project:** Assessment Bond, Series 2017
- (2) **Amount To Be Financed:** \$350,000
- (3) **Interest Rates, Financing Terms and Corresponding Payments:**

<u>Term</u>	<u>Taxable Rate</u>
10 Years	4.19%

Principal & interest payments shall be due annually commencing January 15, 2018 and shall continue each January 15 thereafter through final maturity. Interest on the principal balance of the Bond shall accrue based on a 30/360 day count basis. BB&T must approve of the final amortization schedule.

The interest rate stated above is valid for a closing not later than June 30, 2017. Closing of the financing is contingent upon completing documentation acceptable to BB&T and its counsel.

Our underwriting fee for this transaction is \$3500. All applicable taxes, permits, costs of counsel for the District and any other costs shall be the District’s responsibility and separately payable by the District.

The transaction will be prepayable in whole with a one percent prepayment penalty. As an alternative, the District may choose for the transaction to be noncallable prior to January 15, 2022 and prepayable in whole at any time thereafter. Any amount due hereunder not paid when due shall bear interest at a default rate equal to the interest rate on the Series 2015 Note plus 2% per annum from and after five (5) days after the date due.

- (4) **Financing Documents:**

It shall be the responsibility of the District to retain and compensate counsel to appropriately structure the financing documents according to Florida State statutes. BB&T shall also require the District to provide an unqualified bond counsel opinion. BB&T and its counsel reserve the right to review and approve all documentation before closing.

BB&T will not be required to present the Bond for any payment regarding this transaction.

(5) Security:

The Bond will be secured through special assessments of the District.


BB&T appreciates the opportunity to make this financing proposal and requests to be notified within ten days of this proposal should BB&T be the successful proposer.

BB&T shall have the right to cancel this offer by notifying the District of its election to do so (whether or not this offer has previously been accepted by the District) if at any time prior to the closing there is a material adverse change in the District's financial condition, if we discover adverse circumstances of which we are currently unaware, if we are unable to agree on acceptable documentation with the District or if there is a change in law (or proposed change in law) that changes the economic effect of this financing to BB&T.
