# HARBOUR WATERWAY SPECIAL DISTRICT Meeting Minutes

Tuesday, August 9, 2022

#### I. Introduction

The Harbour Waterway Special District (HSWD) meeting of the Board of supervisors was held on August 9, 2022. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm. In attendance were Rick Fornos, Mark Todd, Walley Lovely, Bob Birtalan, David Prysock and District Manager Stanley Pipes. It was noted that there was a quorum present. Harbour Waterway attorney Wayne Flowers was present. Caroline Birtalan was present as recording secretary.

#### II. Administrative

Approval of minutes from July 12, 2022 – A Motion was made to approve the meeting minutes; Motion Carried.

#### III. District Business

Sovereign Submerged Land Easement- The sovereign submerged land easement survey has been completed by ARC Surveying.

Reed Island Nature Park- The transfer of 77.6 acres to HWSD is currently in progress. A purchase agreement has been exchanged but not finalized and approved.

Isle of Palms Dredging project- At the upcoming IOPSD meeting, proposed actions will be discussed to move forward.

JaxPort Buck Island project- Additional spoil material will be removed from Buck Island at this time and pumped to Reed Island.

HNPA Marina- The purchase of property at 4639 Harbour North CT. has closed and has been filed with the Clerk of Courts. Bids will be put out soon for all needed repairs.

Southern Bulkhead- Under the powerlines, a bulkhead needs to be constructed to prevent material from flowing back into the canal Mill Cove.

Powerline Dredging Project- An estimated 45,000 cubic yards needs to be dredged from underneath the powerlines to Canal Markers 19 / 20.

#### IV. Financial

Approval to disburse funds- A motion was made to approve the disbursements for administrative services, district manager billing, legal services, payroll and withholding tax, removal of scrubs along marsh, pollution insurance, nature park survey, and portable grease gun totaling \$43,868.89; Motion Carried.

Total Available Funds in the HWSD general fund as of July 31, 2022 is \$2,941,539.25. Total Projected Available funds after FY Operating and Project expenses as of June 30, 2023 is \$863,079.02.
